



## Health and Safety Policy

### 1. A FACE COVERING IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY

Governor Greg Abbott has issued Executive Order 29 requiring all Texans to wear a face covering over the nose and mouth in public spaces. Executive Order 29 applies to everyone ages ten (10) and older.

Everyone ten (10) and older, including employees, customers, visitors, contractors, and parents, who enter this business must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth, such as a homemade mask, scarf, bandana, or handkerchief.

#### If you have to ask, wear a mask ....

Austin Ninjas Lobby & Seating Area	Please wear a mask in waiting areas. Must wear a mask when entering/exiting the facility (ages 10+).
Gym	Instructors and staff must wear a mask while teaching. Participants are not required to wear a mask while engaging in strenuous exercise. Social distancing is requested.
Camp	Camp staff is required to wear a mask. Camp parents are required to wear a mask at camp drop off. Campers 10+ are required to wear a mask to enter/exit the facility and are not required to wear a mask while engaging in strenuous exercise. Campers ages 5 to 9 are not required to wear masks. Social distancing is requested.

### 2. SOCIAL DISTANCING IS REQUESTED

With the use of appropriate face coverings, individuals should still maintain six feet of social distancing, whenever possible.

- a. Employees should not work within six (6) feet of one another, except to the extent necessary to perform work duties
- b. Customers should maintain six (6) feet of separation from other individuals outside their household, to the extent feasible when inside the premises

### 3. VIOLATIONS

Customers who do not wear a face covering in the lobby and seating area may be asked to leave the premises, and may not be provided with goods or services until the face covering requirements are followed. Face coverings are available for purchase.
